# CONVERSION OF COMPANY

The Directors have to report that the proposals fully set out in a circular letter to the Members and Debentureholders of the Company, dated June 1946, have been carried out and that the Company was converted into a Public one by Resolution dated 1st August 1946.

#### BANK OVERDRAFT

The overdraft from the Union Bank of Scotland Ltd. has been paid off out of the proceeds of £960 Debentures subscribed for during the year.

# ENTRY FEES

Entry fees received during the year amounted to £414, 15s., bringing this item in the Balance Sheet to £1009, 11s. 5d., which sum the Directors have applied in reduction of the Discount on Debentures account.

### MEMBERSHIP

During the year the membership increased from 209 on 31st August 1945 to 288 on 31st August 1946. As at the date of this Report the number of Members has still further increased to 348. These figures embrace all types of membership.

#### CLUB RULES

The Club Bye-laws have been revised and copies will be sent to Members as soon as they have been reprinted.

#### MANAGEMENT

During the year under review the Board confirmed the appointment of Mr. B. G. BARNES as Manager and Professional to the Club on terms which were adjusted to the mutual satisfaction of the Board and Mr. BARNES. The Board wish to record their appreciation of Mr. BARNES' work on behalf of the Club, particularly during the early period after the re-opening. Without his initiative, enthusiasm and hard work the Club would not now have been re-established.

#### DIRECTORS

During the year Mr. ROBERT F. SHEPHERD and Mr. KENNEDY SMELLIE retired from the Board and the Directors wish to record their sincere appreciation of their work during the war years.

The Director retiring in the ordinary course in terms of the Articles is Mr. BALFOUR. He is eligible for re-election.
